- Did you know that VA's <u>Aid and Attendance and Housebound benefits</u> can increase your pension payments to support the additional care you need? If you need help with daily activities, or if you are housebound, you may qualify for an increased VA pension to help pay for in-home care, assisted living, or a nursing home.
- The 2024 Veterans disability compensation rates are in! Starting Jan. 1, 2024, all compensation benefit rates have increased by 3.2% to match adjustments made to Social Security benefits. This increase impacts <u>disability benefits</u>, <u>clothing allowance</u>, <u>dependency and indemnity compensation</u> (<u>DIC</u>), as well as other VA assistance programs.
- <u>Meals on Wheels</u> is a life-sustaining program that allows seniors who are unable to leave their homes to shop, or have difficulty preparing a meal, to have healthy meals delivered to their homes. While the diversity of each program's services and operations may vary based on the needs and resources of its community, Meals on Wheels is committed to supporting nearly 2.4 million seniors live healthier and more nourished lives. Find the program closest to you or a loved one this holiday season.
- After filing a disability claim, you may have some lingering questions about what comes next in the claims process. Many Veterans wonder what will happen at their <u>VA claim exam</u> (also known as a compensation and pension, or C&P exam). To help answer these questions, VA has updated two websites to <u>provide current</u> information on frequently asked questions.
- Are you interested in filing a VA claim or appeal? <u>American Legion</u> provides expert assistance to Veterans and their families, free of charge. American Legion service officers are trained to help you develop your claim, while also providing referrals and resources on education, employment, and more. For help with your claim, contact the American Legion service officer at their nearest VA regional office.
