OBJECT 100: IRAQ BURN PIT

A year after returning from Iraq with severe respiratory problems in 2008, Capt. Le Roy Torres and his wife founded *Burn Pits 360* to raise awareness of the health hazards of burn pit emissions. Over a decade of persistent advocacy by Burn Pits 360 and other Veterans groups paid off with passage of the PACT Act in 2022, the largest expansion of Veterans benefits since the 1944 GI Bill.
